Wait A Minute!

From this point forward all of our normal Sunday and Wednesday activities and services are cancelled. However, we will broadcast services on Sunday mornings beginning at 10:00 AM. You can join us on Facebook live (First Christian Church Facebook page). I am working to make the broadcast available on either our website or another venue for those who do not do Facebook. Check our website (fccdumas.org) for further information.

In addition, on Easter Sunday morning (April 12th), we will have a drive in worship service in our new church parking lot. You can drive in; stay in your car; roll down your windows; or listen on your car radio. We will broadcast our services through a small FM transmitter and let you know the channel when you pull in.

Then, following Easter, we will return to broadcasting our services through Facebook. We will worship this way until further notice.

There will be three to four of us in the auditorium making the broadcast work, and if you would like to join us here at the church you are more than welcome. As long as we do not go crazy and have more than 10 to 15 and we maintain a safe distance.

If you need anything - someone to pick something up at the store; to take you some where - call me at the church or on my cell phone. I would be glad to help when and where I can.
