Wait A Minute!

I watch the Andy Griffith Show early on Saturday mornings. I remember when Andy was out of town and Barney, the deputy, is "sheriff" for the day. Barney deputizes Gomer, the gas station attendant. They are walking through town that evening when they notice someone robbing the bank. They hide behind a car. They are afraid and fear leads to inaction. Finally, Gomer speaks up: "Shazam Barney! We need to call the police." Barney replies: "We are the police."

In the same way: We are the church. If you are "in Christ" and Christ is in you; then it doesn't matter when or how or where you worship; you are the church. And together, we are the church.
