## The Good News August 5, 2020

#### Wait A Minute!

Life's transitions: consider a few. First day of kindergarten. Freshman year of High School. Graduation. Marriage. Parenthood. Relocation. Empty nest. Becoming a grandparent. Retirement. Zoom ... life passes by and we experience various transitions.

You might even say that Covid-19 is a transition because we have witnessed many changes since March. But in light of all these transitions, we need to recall these words of Jesus: "Let not your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in Me." (John 14:1) His disciples had faced many transitions leading up to these words.

Earlier in the week the crowds exalted Him; later in the week, they condemned Him. On Sunday, the people declared Him king and prepared to present Him the crown; on this Thursday when Jesus spoke these words, the people accused Him of treason and called for His death.

With all this taking place, the disciples were proud and then frightened. Relaxed and then worried. Their hearts were filled with joy and excitement and then at the murmuring of the crowd their hearts became anxious and troubled.

So Jesus presented them the Rolaid for spiritual heartburn – faith and trust. "Believe in God," Jesus said, "and believe also in Me." In the face of all these transitions the calm voice of the Master called for trust.

"You have placed your trust in Me the last three years when everything was well. Now trust me as your world begins to fall apart. Have faith that what is happening (these radical transitions) will be transformed into something even greater."

So, in the coming days as school begins we might have some transitions. Some will begin kindergarten. Others will make the move to the intermediate school. A few reading this will see their recent high school graduate go off to college. I even know one couple who received news that they will be grandparents again.

So as transitions take place in this month and during this time, take the words of Jesus and plant them in your heart. "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in Me."
