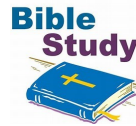

The Minor Prophets “Major Words from the Minor Leagues”

Wait A Minute!

These words from the prophet Joel have been speaking to me. “Even now,” declares the Lord, “return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning.” (Joel 2:12)

Dissect this phrase. Returns implies that one needs to turn back because one has walked in the opposite direction, in this case, away from God. With all your heart indicates understanding. And fasting, weeping, and mourning will then demonstrate seriousness.

Here is the Darrell Wait paraphrase geared at Scriptural application. “Come back to Me,” the Lord whispers; “I’ve missed you. Spend some time in prayer so that you can tell me what’s going on in your world. And then spend a few moments each day in My word so that I can remind you how you should live in your world. Then, without drawing attention to yourself, give something up that you need, that’s important to you; and share what you give up with someone in need. In this way, you are sharing with me and thus demonstrating that you are serious about walking with Me”

As always, thank you for the opportunity of ministry and I do look forward to worshipping with you this Sunday.
