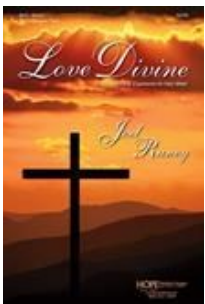

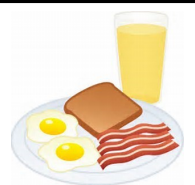

Wait A Minute!

Choice: Do we really have a choice? Or, are we tumble weeds blown along through life in randomness that some would call fate. 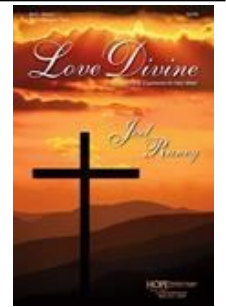
