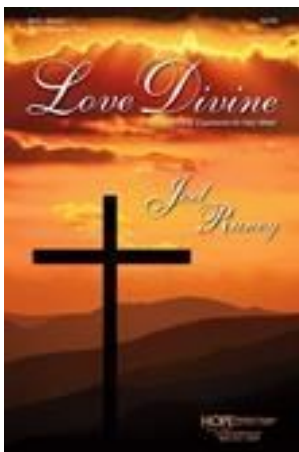

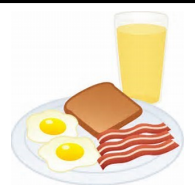

**Wait A Minute!**

I find the original Palm Sunday event to be one of the most unique events during the life and ministry of Jesus. It began with a parade as Jesus entered Jerusalem. People gathered to watch as He rode into town on a donkey. They shouted: “Hosanna! Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.” They waved palm branches in the air. They threw garments as a red carpet on the streets. They were prepared to declare Jesus as King (or Lord of their life.) They would follow Him into battle; and declare themselves free from Roman tyranny. They would follow Jesus anywhere. They would do anything he asked. They were ready to make a no holds barred commitment to him ... on this day. Intriguing.

Now jump forward four days. Another crowd has gathered around the courthouse and they are calling for the crucifixion of Jesus. “Crucify him!” they shout. “Give us Barabbas,” they demand. More intriguing.

And then most intriguing: The same people crowding into the streets with palms is for the most part, the same crowd gathered at the courthouse with angry fists. They failed to see the large chasm that existed between what they really needed and what they wanted. And when Jesus would not give them what they wanted, they turned on Him so quickly.

So every Palm Sunday I think about those two crowds and ask myself: “In which crowd do I really stand?” Do I ignore Jesus when He doesn’t give me what I want? Or am I willing to follow Jesus anywhere because He has freely given me everything I need?

Make sure to be here on Sunday as the choir leads in worship with a special presentation about God’s love. You will certainly enjoy it. I hope to see you then.
