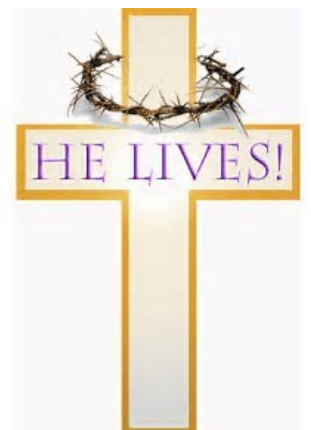

As always, thanks for the opportunity of service and I look forward to celebrating with you this Sunday.

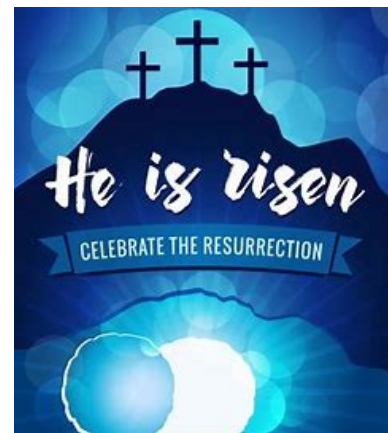
