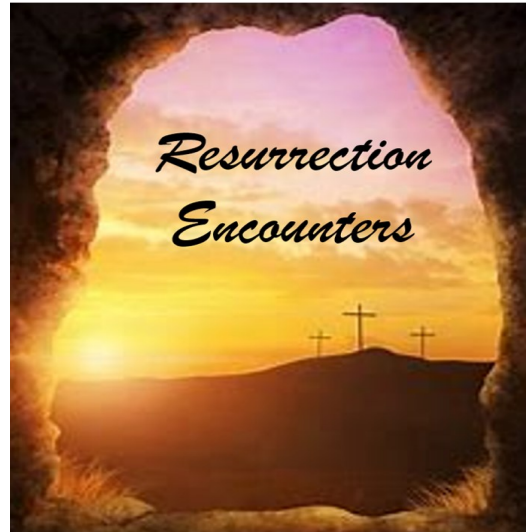

This Week - “Believing Without Seeing”

Wait A Minute!

Convinced of the resurrection? If so, then, what now? In 1 Corinthians 15, verse 57, we find this declaration: “But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.” The word “give” is in the present tense and denotes a continuous process of victory. God gives us the victory over sin on the cross because of the atoning sacrifice of Jesus. God gives us the victory over anything and everything, because of the hope found in the resurrection. And one day, God will give us the ultimate victory over death, which is eternal life with Him.

Following that declaration Paul then writes: “Therefore, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord.”

My extended paraphrase of these two verses. “Convinced of the victory that comes from the resurrected Jesus Christ, be alive with joy; moved by faith; inspired by hope; stirred by injustice; dedicated to worship; dependent upon prayer; overflowing with gratitude; overwhelming with grace; and abounding in love.”

If the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most pivotal day in world history (and we believe that it is); then resurrection belief should invoke from us the most pivotal awakening of our spiritual senses. So thanks be to God, this day and every day, for the victory he gives to us through the resurrected Jesus, our Lord.

I look forward to celebrating the resurrection every Sunday with you.
