Wait A Minute!

Easter Sunday morning has come and gone again! I'm still intrigued by that statement in John 20, that we read often on this past Sunday during my time: "She (Mary Magdalene) turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus." I hope and pray that statement does not describe my life or yours as we move forward. He is near. He is interested. And more than anything else, He desires to be involved.

As we move forward this Spring, we will see other resurrection encounters. Jesus must have encountered some Roman soldiers who stood guard. He did encounter two followers on the road to Emmaus. He encountered his disciples as they gathered in Galilee. He encountered old

doubting Thomas, and took up Thomas' double dog dare: "Put your finger here; see my hands." And Thomas then had no doubt!


