Wait A Minute!

Just like the previous two weeks, what does God promise? God promises to comfort you with the calmest assurance of eternity, His very own presence. Jesus reminded His disciples: "I will not leave you as orphans . . . I come to you forever." "Abide in Me . . . and I will abide in you." "Remember. I am with you always . . . even to the end of the earth." For a summary of this promise, the preacher of the sermon spoken to the Hebrew Christians writes: "I will never desert you, nor will I forsake you."

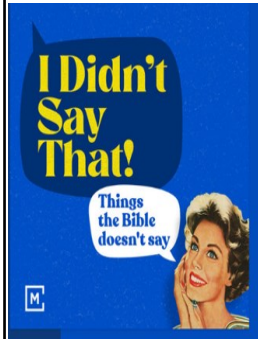
