The passengers, meanwhile, were told of each maneuver in that calm, cheery voice pilots manage to use at times like this. Flight attendants glided about the cabin with an air of cool reserve. That's what prayer should be but quite honestly for me, that's not what prayer always is. Let's covenant together that we will pray for everything without becoming anxious for anything.


After a week off, I'm looking forward to worshipping with you this Sunday. See you then.


