Wait A Second!

Last fall I introduced the Hebrew term: "Tohu-wabohu," which means, formless and void; or a shapeless chaotic mess. In Genesis 1, that was the description give to matter before God began His creative work. God then demonstrated through His creative power; and then again with His miraculous works; and then again through the resurrection of Jesus; and then again numerous times, more than likely in your life and mine; that He will have the final say. He will have the final word even when we are describing our existence as "tohu-wa-bohu;" a shapeless, chaotic mess.

I am reminded of the couple who had one of those silly, simple spats one morning as they prepared for work. The wife said: "I did not!" Too which the husband responded:

Again, while she cleaned the breakfast dishes she emphasized: "I did not!" And while the husband prepared sack lunches for both of them he replied: "You did too!"

Finally, as she walked out the door with a slam, the wife spoke: "I did not!" And off she drove to work smug in her belief that she had gotten in the last word.

At lunch she bit into the sandwich her husband prepared during the argument, and felt an unfamiliar substance. She opened the sandwich and extracted a soggy piece of paper. Scribbled on it were these words: "You did

We may believe life is currently "tohu-wa-bohu" but in the end or the long run God will have the final word. And he says this: "In all things God works together for good, to those who love God and who have been called according to His purpose." A promise that no one and nothing can prevent God from accomplishing His will. He will speak the last word.

At times, that Romans 8:28 promise is the only handle to hold onto. So, I pass it along to you today. God will have the final word even when you are in the middle of "tohu-wa-bohu."
