### Wait A Couple of Minutes:

We continued this video ministry even after we returned to worship in the sanctuary. Currently, 30-40 people watch our services at some point each week. We only have one individual (Holly) who operates the camera and the software for each service. We need three or four volunteers so that we can make a schedule and no one has to operate the software more than once a month. If you are interested, let me know; and we will have a training period. The reality is this: Once everything is connected and operating correctly, the actual running of the software is really quite simple.

Second, beginning in September, we will return to a much more normal (for us) worship service. This will involve our elders serving at the communion table and a liturgist reading the Scriptures and handling the offertory prayer. If you would like to participate as a liturgist, please sign the sign up list in the foyer or in the fellowship hall; and you will then be included on the schedule.

And then third, because I ran out of room last week: Thank you so much for the privilege of serving in this church and I look forward to worshipping with you this Sunday.
