Bob McKamie passed away early Monday morning. While living in Waco, Bob and Mary Beth were to our family like many of you are to our family: "Family."

Speaking to Mary Beth on Monday evening I told her this about Bob: "When I look up the definition of integrity, I see a picture of Bob McKamie." I have no doubt that the church will be filled to capacity on Friday when they have a memorial service; and the overflow crowd will be a testimony to his testimony.

Hebrews 11:4 reads: "By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead." I can easily apply this verse to my friend Bob and say: "By faith Bob will continue to speak even though he is gone."

The Scottish theologian James Moffatt said: "Death

is never the last word in the life of a righteous man." Bob's integrity stood as a testimony to his character while he was living; and Bob's integrity will now serve as a legacy to the kind of life he lived.

The last couple of years Bob suffered from dementia; and as dementia can do, it became more severe. In these final days, he really did not know who he was or where he lived or to whom he was married.

So, because of that, I do not mourn his passing but I rejoice in his homecoming. I will miss the example he has set for hundreds of Christ-followers who knew him; and I will continue to pray that God will empower me to have the same consistency in my life that was so obvious and visible in his. For I know that that consistency was the source of his integrity. For the life that he lived, he lived for the Son of God; but more than that, it was the Son of God living through him.
