And, according to a friend of mine who is in the candy business, more chocolate is sold for this occasion than for any other occasion.

And we do all of this in an effort to say, “I love you.” And Valentine’s Day remains a special time for expressing love.

When God wanted to say to the world, “I love you;” He didn’t send a card; He didn’t send flowers; He sent His Son Jesus.
